

Fostering joy, warmth, and intergenerational connection for low-income seniors in Chicago since 1982



to create and nourish a true living community of elderly people who care for and about each other.

In 1983, a year after its founding, H.O.M.E. bought 1537 W. Rosemont in the Edgewater neighborhood from the Archdiocese of Chicago and transformed it into "a shared intergenerational, interracial living arrangement for the elderly."

Named for Pat Crowley, the noted Chicago Catholic layman, lawyer and philanthropist, the property thrives as intergenerational shared living, where 12 low-income seniors live in a family-like setting – shared meals, common areas, and activities – with 4 younger Resident Assistants (rent free), and a family with children.



H.O.M.E.'s underlying philosophy is that older adults flourish when they are treated with great respect.

Good Life Senior Residences offer private rooms, two meals per day, outings, services, and on-site health check-ups and tutorials through H.O.ME.'s community partners – all for low-income older people.

Resident Assistants, typically young adults, live on-site and assist residents with housekeeping and laundry, and share creative and social activities.
