#### What is H.O.M.E.?

Housing Opportunities & Maintenance for the Elderly (H.O.M.E.) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to fostering joy, independence, and connection among low-income seniors in Chicago.

H.O.M.E. operates three intergenerational residences – including Nathalie Salmon House – in the city. H.O.M.E. also provides home repair services on the south and west sides, and citywide, moving assistance and a shopping bus for senior buildings.











#### Nathalie Salmon House

In 1994, H.O.M.E. opened <u>Nathalie Salmon House</u>, named in memory of the teenage daughter of H.O.M.E.'s founders Michel and Lilo Salmon. Their vision was to honor Nathalie — who passed away after being struck by a car — by creating a community where people of all ages lived and learned from one another. That vision continues today.

For 30 years, Nathalie Salmon House has provided a vibrant intergenerational living experience for low-income seniors, families with children, and younger adults.

The first intentionally-built intergenerational affordable housing residence in Chicago, Nathalie Salmon House continues to be a national model of intergenerational living, with awards from Generations United, the Chicago Community Trust, Fannie Mae, and others.


